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Introduction to the 12 Bhavas (Houses) of Destiny

In Vedic astrology (Jyotish), your birth chart is divided into 12 distinct segments called **Bhavas (Houses)**. Each house represents a specific department of human experience—ranging from physical appearance and accumulated wealth to career authority, romantic bonds, and ultimate spiritual liberation (Moksha).

Detailed Meaning and Significance of All 12 Houses

House	Sanskrit Name	Key Life Significations (Karakattwas)
1st House	Tanu Bhava (Ascendant / Lagna)	Physical body, health, vitality, self-identity, temperament, overall life trajectory.
2nd House	Dhana / Kutumba Bhava	Accumulated wealth, liquid assets, family lineage, speech, vocal tone, food habits.



House	Sanskrit Name	Key Life Significations (Karakattwas)
3rd House	Sahaja / Bhratri Bhava	Younger siblings, courage, physical stamina, short journeys, communication, writing skills.
4th House	Bandhu / Sukha Bhava	Mother, home environment, landed property, real estate, vehicles, inner peace, heart.
5th House	Putra / Buddhi Bhava	Children, intellect, higher learning, creativity, past-life merits (Purva Punya), speculation.
6th House	Ari / Roga / Shatru Bhava	Enemies, diseases, debts, daily routine, service profession, competitive exams, litigation.
7th House	Kalatra / Yuvati Bhava	Spouse, marital harmony, business partnerships, legal contracts, public image.
8th House	Ayur / Randhra Bhava	Longevity, sudden transformations, hidden wealth, occult sciences, research, secrets.
9th House	Dharma / Bhagya Bhava	Father, Guru, higher philosophy, divine fortune, long pilgrimage journeys, righteousness.
10th House	Karma / Rajya Bhava	Career, profession, social status, government authority, public recognition, ambitions.
11th House	Labha / Aya Bhava	Financial gains, fulfilling desires, networking circles, elder siblings, cash flow.
12th House	Vyaya / Moksha Bhava	Expenditures, foreign travel/settlement, subconscious dreams, bed pleasures, spiritual liberation.

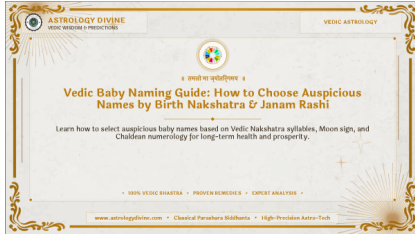
The 4 Great Purushartha House Triads

- **Dharma Trikona (1st, 5th, 9th):** Righteous conduct, ethics, inner divine calling, and cosmic destiny.
- **Artha Trikona (2nd, 6th, 10th):** Material sustenance, career discipline, wealth accumulation, and duties.
- **Kama Trikona (3rd, 7th, 11th):** Ambitions, romantic desires, social fulfillment, and networking.
- **Moksha Trikona (4th, 8th, 12th):** Emotional depth, transcendental meditation, spiritual detachment, and soul release.

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
